EQUITY INSTRUCTIONAL ROUNDS

Equity Instructional Rounds are professional development and information-gathering events designed to identify patterns across classrooms and buildings that can be addressed in order to build consistent and equitable instructional practices. This collaborative process invites a team of educators and students to join our facilitators in observing classrooms.

Through visits to classrooms and other learning environments, teams collect evidence of student learning and engagement and the practices of adults. Equity Rounds are not designed to provide feedback to individual educators but rather to identify system wide patterns, trends, and anomalies.

This process provides an opportunity to share the evidence collected and to identify high leverage patterns and trends.

West Wind's skilled facilitators support Rounds participants to identify the priority areas they want to address and to design research-based actions that will lead to sustained improvement over time. The information and feedback gathered from the Rounds is used to develop and support targeted professional learning and action planning for the school or district.
