EQUITY INSTRUCTIONAL ROUNDS

West Wind's Equity Instructional Rounds are professional development and information-gathering events designed to identify patterns across classrooms and buildings that can be addressed in order to build consistent and equitable instructional practices. Instructional Rounds engage teachers, staff, administrators, and students in a facilitated process to explore the strengths and challenges in their learning environments and plan together for continuous improvement

Built on the model designed at Harvard University, West Wind's Instructional Rounds include visits to classrooms and other learning environments to collect evidence of student learning and engagement and the practices of teachers, staff, and administrators. Rounds are not designed to focus on individual educators but rather to engage groups of educators and students in identifying system-wide patterns, trends, and anomalies.

West Wind's skilled facilitators support Rounds participants to identify the priority areas they want to address and to use research to design actions that will lead to sustained improvement over time. West Wind coaches leaders to use the information and feedback gathered from Rounds to develop and support targeted professional learning and action planning for the school or district.
